

EVACUATION/EMERGENCY PLAN

These instructions should be followed in the event of fire or other emergency that would require the building to be evacuated:

1. When a fire alarm sounds EVERYONE must exit their apartment. You may not choose to ignore the warning.
2. DO NOT attempt to use the elevators. Proceed to exit the building using the nearest stairwell. Stairwells are marked by exit signs and are also indicated on signage near the elevator.
3. There are two stairwells located in each tower. One inside by the elevators and the other is outside near the entrance to the parking garage.
4. Once you exit and are outside of the building all residents should gather in the TCU parking lot located across from Perrotti's Pizza. Further instructions will be given from this point from TCU/GrandMarc staff.
5. If the area is under a tornado warning and you hear tornado sirens, the safest place is either inside your bathroom, North Tower Media Room, or in the corridor hallway on the 2nd floor in both towers. The building is a concrete structure and the corridors are not open on the ends, and do not have windows. The corridors are the safest place, furthest from the exterior.
6. In the event of any emergency you should always monitor local media for the latest updates. The GrandMarc Staff will also communicate information to all residents whenever possible.
